First and foremost, Royal on the Park is proud to join forces with Green Globe in sustaining the Travel and Tourism industry by becoming an environmentally friendly organisation. Green Globe assists organisations improve economic, social and environmental sustainability and to demonstrate the tangible results of their Corporate Social Responsibility objectives by through benchmarking procedures. The five Green Globe Standards are designed to assist organisations, such as Royal on the Park to increase their sustainability of operations.

Stewart Moore, CEO of EC3 Global, the management company of Green Globe, says: "We are thrilled to be welcoming Royal on the Park to the Green Globe programme. Royal on the Park is a prime example of how tourism operators can demonstrate their commitment to environmental responsibility without diminishing their guests quality experience. They have set a strong example for others to follow."

Some further procedures in becoming greener include:

- Energy consumption can be measured from a spreadsheet which tracks the progress of electricity, gas and water usage throughout the hotel and it's grounds
- Shower heads in all guest rooms are compliant with Brisbane's water restrictions policy (Level 5 as at October 2007). Each shower head restricting flow to 9 litres of water per minute.
- Guests are given the option of having their towels replaced every second day to save on water
- Compact Fluorescent light bulbs in all accommodation rooms
- Plastic, paper, glass, oil and printer cartridges are recycled
- Cooking oil and all packaging is recycled
- Adding green practices to the hotel's business plan
- Location of the hotel is close to public transport

The hotel aims to provide a commitment in achieving sustainable benefits to make Royal on the Park a preferred choice in accommodation and event venues.
